### 3. Leverage Ratio

In November 2018, the Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB) issued its final Leverage regulation, with an effective date of 30 June 2019. The leverage ratio is a simple ratio that serves as a supplementary measure to the risk-based capital requirements. It aims to constrain the build-up of leverage in banking sector, reinforce the risk-based requirements with a simple non-risk based "backstop" measure, and serve as a broad measure of both the on and off-balance sheet sources of bank leverage.

The leverage ratio is measured as Tier 1 Capital divided by Total Exposures. Total Exposures consist of on-balance sheet, off-balance sheet, derivatives and securities financing transactions exposures. As per CBB regulations, Bahraini banks must meet a 3% leverage ratio minimum requirement at all times, except for Domestic Systemically Important Banks (DSIBs), where the minimum ratio is higher at 3.75%. Accordingly, as a DSIB bank, the minimum ratio applicable for BBK is 3.75%. As of 30 September 2024, the leverage ratio for BBK stood at a healthy position of 13.39%.
